- 1 Left untreated, dental issues can lead to serious infections and pain.

DID YOU KNOW?

More than **90%** of all systemic diseases are linked to oral health. Poor oral health can lead to and escalate serious overall health issues.

- 75% of Americans have some form of gum disease.¹
- Patients with even mild periodontal disease were 2X as likely to have a stroke compared with those with healthy mouths.²
- The mouth can serve as an important early-warning system for more than **120** diseases.¹

TERMS TO KNOW

WAITING PERIOD

The amount of time a member must wait before some or all of their coverage comes into effect.

ANNUAL MAXIMUM

The total amount the Kaiser Permanente Dental plan will pay for a member's dental care within a 12-month period.

PREVENTIVE

Services such as exams, X-rays, dental cleanings, and fluoride treatment.

BASIC

Services such as fillings, extractions, and root canals.

MAJOR

Services such as crowns, dentures, and fixed partial dentures.



COMMUNITY BENEFIT AND PAYMENT PLAN OPTIONS

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

To qualify for assistance, you must have annual gross household income no greater than 300% of the federal poverty level. There is a \$2,000 per-member-per-year limit on dental financial assistance. You are only eligible every other year. You must pay for items or services that do not qualify, and all charges above \$2,000. Assistance will not cover care received outside our Oregon-Southwest Washington service area.

PAYMENT PLANS

Kaiser Permanente offers no-interest payment plan options. You are responsible for a minimum of a 25% down payment of expected out-of-pocket liability.
